Orchard Court was transformed by the Hollybank Trust from an old garage into a £2 million, 30-bed residential care home for severely mentally and physically disabled young people. Three separate units were constructed consisting of 1-6 bed unit and 2-12 bed units, along with kitchen, dining areas and communal lounges.

West Port was able to supply products to Triton Construction that met all their requirements for making the residents' stay more comfortable.

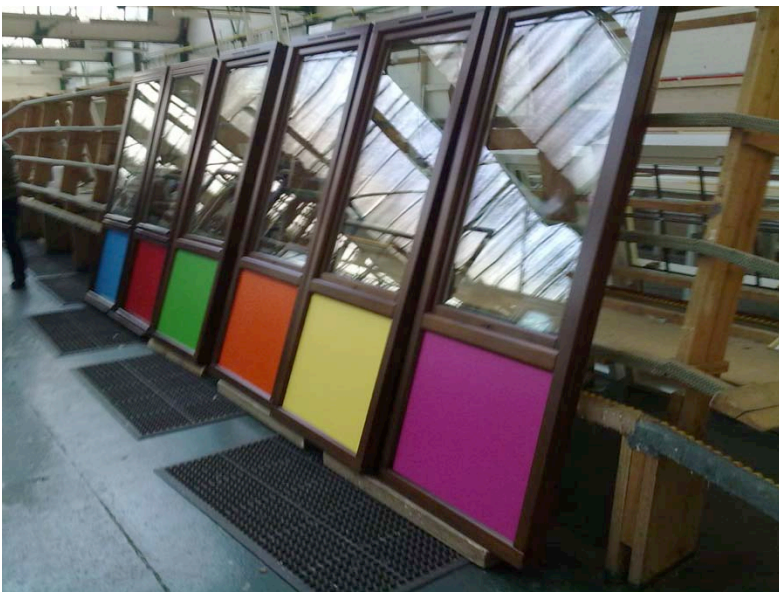
All West Port's timber doors are fitted with a low aluminium threshold as standard, suitable for wheelchairs and wheeled beds, but extra-wide doors were needed to make it easier for carers to wheel chairs and beds in and out of the rooms so that the bed-ridden could enjoy fine weather in the garden, and in case of fire.

The doors were provided with a special three point locking mechanism to enable the residents to open the door from the inside even when locked, to ensure safe escape from the building in an emergency.

All the doors and windows were painted in bright contemporary colours to fit in with the contemporary style of the building and add extra colour to stimulate the residents.

Doors had to be half-glazed to a specific height so that residents could enjoy the view outdoors from their chair or bed.

West Port provided top hung Raven Craig System X windows - the easiest type of window for the residents to open. They also have a restricted hinge to prevent any resident from accidentally falling out of the window.
