After laying dormant for many years due to a fire in the 1980's, Hamilton Grand has now received a much-needed overhaul, transforming it into 26 luxury apartments ranging from 1,133 to 2,780 square feet. One of the apartments, with a price tag of £7.3million, overlooks the 18th hole of the famous St. Andrews golf course.

West Port provided ISG Construction with traditional cords and weights sliding sash timber windows for the 115 year-old Grade B listed building.

The building's owner wanted the windows to be finished in black, but Scottish Heritage required them to be finished in green. West Port approached their paint supplier in Germany to provide a special green/black paint that could satisfy both parties.

All the windows were painted in West Port's factory in Cumbria in a dual finish; the special green/black finish to the outside and either black or cream inside, depending on the room.

The building's proximity to the sea meant that the ironmongery had to undergo 2,000 hours of salt spray testing to ensure its durability under the adverse conditions.

Some of the building's windows had curved heads, which were manufactured in West Point's joinery shop using templates to make sure the curves were manufactured to the right shape and size to fit into the building correctly.
